The Predator Bay Water Ski Club is proud to host Canadian Water Ski Western Championships, In Memory of Vern Oberg and Presented by MasterCraft on July 27-29, 2018. Predator Bay is going into it's 21st season. The club is proud to have previously hosted 4 Canadian Nationals; 3 Canadian Westerns; multiple Provincial championships; 3 MasterCraft Pro Water Ski Events; and the 2009 World Water Ski Championships.

CANADIAN WATER SKI WESTERNS

Canadian Water Ski Westerns will start on Friday, July 27 with familiarization for all western provinces. Westerns events will run morning and afternoon from Saturday through Sunday. The Canadian Water Ski Western Championships will be awarded in a 1 round tournament style. It is a 3 event WRL tournament.

**PBAY WESTERNS ROUNDUP SLALOM

Prior to the Canadian Water Ski Westerns, Predator Bay will host a SLALOM ONLY (WRL) tournament on Friday, July 27. This event is limited to the first 40 skiers that register AND priority is given to:

1. Skiers who need a score (LCQ) to ski in Westerns
2. Skiers who will also register and ski in Western

Sun. July 29	Westerns Round 1 continuation if needed Westerns Round 2 Slalom only	8am to 3pm

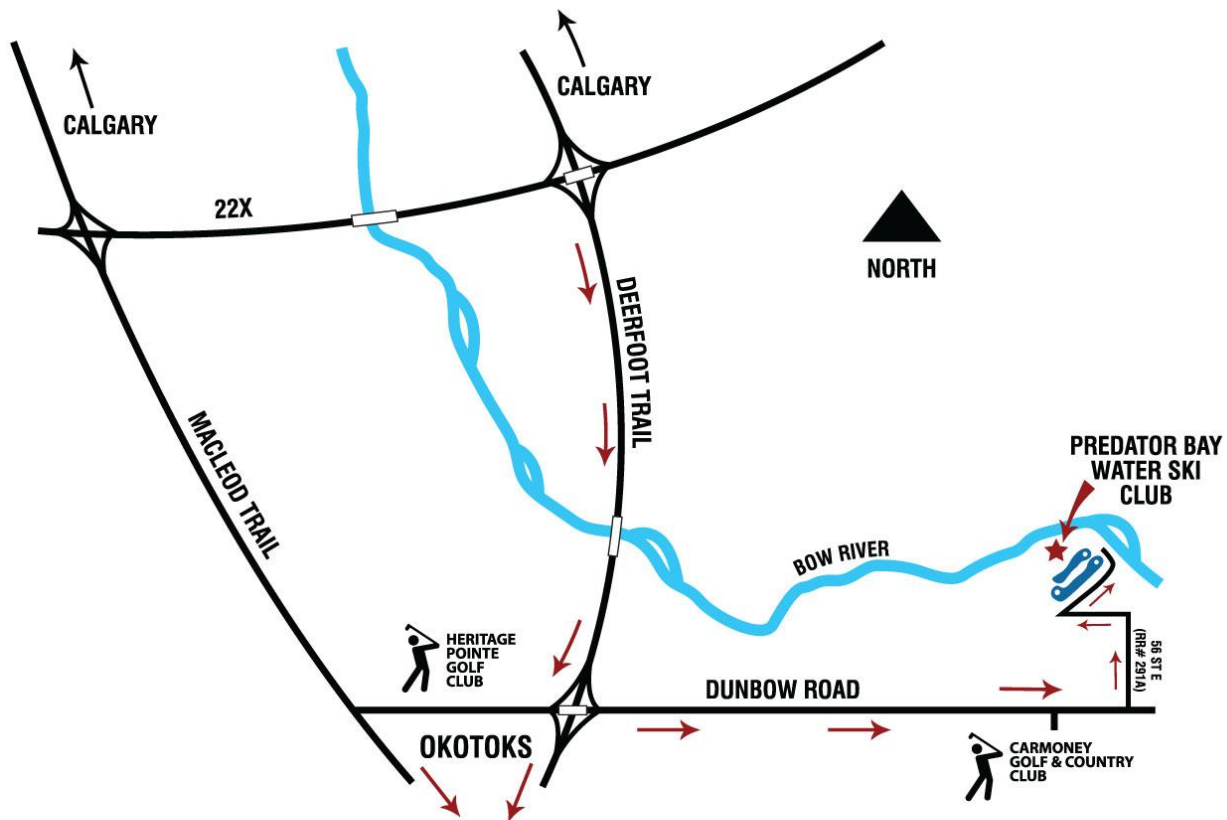
